Burlington Adult Day Service Integrated Programs

Integrated ADS Programs are intended for older adults who may be frail and cannot participate in community based recreational programs. Adults who attend Integrated Programs may be socially isolated, or need personal care support due to a chronic condition such as stroke, Parkinson's Disease, diabetes, and/or early to moderate stages of dementia.

Programs provide social, recreational, cognitive and physical activities in a structured and supervised setting. Services include a nutritious meal, refreshments, medication reminders and personal care assistance. All programs offer a senior based daily exercise program designed to promote physical well-being and optimize health. Refer to the chart below for additional services offered at each site. ADS Programs will facilitate transportation services as available.

**Burlington Adult Day Service <u>Alzheimer Disease/ Dementia Programs</u> (For persons with moderate to advanced dementia)

Alzheimer Disease/ Dementia_Programs are intended for adults who have a moderate or advanced dementia and require frequent cuing, direction, and supervision. Specialized Programs offer small group settings and constant staff support and supervision. Staff offer assistance with behavioral habits, provide guidance and cuing during all activities and help with personal care needs.**

Programs include social, recreational, cognitive and physical activities within a secure and locked facility so that participants are safe from wandering outside of the Program.

Services provided will include a full course hot meal, refreshments, medication reminders and personal care assistance. All offer a senior based daily exercise program designed to promote physical well-being and optimize health.

Financial assistance with the Program fee may be available to individuals who qualify. ADS Programs will facilitate transportation services as available. Refer to the chart below for additional services offered at each site.
